

## Adriatic Sailing Week 2027 Classic

**Event Period:**

Sunday, 19.09.2027 until Thursday, 20.09.2027

**Charter Period:**

Saturday, 18.09.2027 until Saturday, 22.09.2027

**Organizer and Race Management:**

Yacht Club Biograd in cooperation with sailingmotion-yachtcharter and race director Christian Kargl

**Rules:**

The Adriatic Sailing Week is governed by the "Race Rules of Sailing" (WRS) of World Sailing for 2025-2028, the rules of the Offshore Racing Congress (ORC) in their current form, the sailing instructions, the class regulations, and this notice of race. For safety, the "Special Regulations Category 4" of ORC (coastal waters) apply, with the exception of rules 3.11, 4.24.8, and 4.24.9. The "Two-Turn Penalty" according to WRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be applied. The anti-doping regulations of the Austrian Federal Sports Organization are also in effect.

**Yachts:**

Following yachts are available to take part:

10x First 35 with Gennaker (asymmetric Spinnaker) from Marina Jezera

10x First 36 with Gennaker (asymmetric Spinnaker) from Marina Biograd

**1.Race:**

Start: Monday, 20.09.2027, 11:00 Uhr

**Routing:**

Kornati islands

Exact routing will be announced before the race

**Permit:**

Yachts of the types First 35 and First 36 are authorized and can be booked through sailingmotion-yachtcharter. All equipment taken over during check-in must remain on board (tools, life jackets, dishes, cushions, fenders, gangway, lines, blocks, etc.). It is allowed to bring additional personal equipment on board (e.g., extra life jackets, tools, lines, blocks, etc.). Removing furniture, doors, or equipment items is not permitted.

Additional class rules include: the anchor and chain must stay at the bow. To avoid damage, the anchor should, if possible, be stored in the anchor locker. Lazy-Jack and Lazy-Bag must remain mounted on the mast/boom but can be rolled up. Adjusting the shrouds is possible with notification to the race management and after signing a liability waiver with the charterer. Changing the mainsheet routing is permitted. The use of personal spinnaker sheets, blocks, barber haulers, etc., is allowed. Original equipment must remain on board. The water tank may be emptied. The diesel tank must be full upon handover. Teams are responsible for cleaning the underwater hull; however, this should be clarified beforehand with the charterer or sailingmotion-yachtcharter to avoid damage to the antifouling coating.

All skippers must possess a valid sailing license to demonstrate the necessary knowledge and qualifications for safely operating the sailing yacht and must be members of a national sailing association. All yachts must be adequately insured against liability damages.

**Registration at the race office, control and control measurement of the yachts:**

The exact position of the race office will be announced before the event. There you will get your starting number (in case, the yachts are without numbers)

Opening Hours: Sunday, 19.09.2027, from 17:00 until 19:00

**Racing Course:**

Courses will be sailed without length or time limits. Several up-and-down courses and navigation races are planned.

**Briefing:**

Briefing, 1. Race:

Monday, 20.09.2027, 09:30 – Skippers briefing

Monday, 20.09.2027, 11:00 - Start of the 1<sup>st</sup> race

The daily skippers briefing takes place on each racing day from 09:00. Take attention to the „black board“.

**Rating**

Seven races are scheduled, with one elimination. If fewer than four races are sailed, no elimination will occur. The overall ranking of the yachts will be determined according to the ORC Club Performance Line. The overall ranking corresponds to Appendix A of the WRS. Prizes will be awarded even if only one race is sailed.

**Groups:**

The First 35 and First 36 cruising yacht categories compete for the Adriatic Sailing Week title in a single classification. The yachts will start together and be classified according to the ORC Club Performance Line. The First 35 and First 36 one-design classes will also receive their own class classification. The ORC Open class will also receive its own classification.

**Advertising:**

Advertising on sails, hull, and railing is permitted. Any other PR event or advertising during the event requires the organizer's approval. The following advertising spaces on participating yachts must be kept clear for the organizer's advertising: 20% of the hull in the bow area, flags on the backstay, and parts of the main boom.

**Television and press recordings:**

Participants agree that recordings of participating yachts and persons on the water and on land may be made, and that these may be broadcast or printed without restriction in image and sound.

**Prices:**

- 1. - 3. Place First 35 mit Gennaker
- 1. - 3. Place First 36 mit Gennaker
- 1. - 3. Place ORC Open

Special prize for the overall winner based on points.

Blue Ribbon for the fastest yacht according to sailing time without discarded results as well as prizes for the daily winners according to calculated time.

**Liability:**

Participants sail at their own risk (WRS4). The organizers and all those involved in the organization of the regatta are not liable for any loss, damage, or injury to persons, yachts, or anything else, whether on water or on land.

A deposit insurance is recommended, the best option will be sent out with the first briefing for ASW 2025 with all details on routing and procedure at the latest after the yacht raffle.

**Entry Fee for the Yachts: € 0,-**

Includes: Entire organization and handling of the yachts, group allocation, race management and jury, registration and payment of fees with the Croatian Sailing Federation, daily results, laying buoys, speedboat to ensure quick processing on the water, three times berth fees in the marinas - further details after the route and briefing, national park, registration with authorities and harbor master.

**Entry Fee per Person € 390,- Payable in cash on site at registration.**

Includes: Welcome dinner on Sunday (multi-course menu including drinks), midweek dinner, multi-course final menu in the destination port including drinks, use of marina facilities, Adriatic Sailing Week present, participant registration, press support.

**Raffle, deposit for the starting number**

All boats will be raffled off at least one week before the regatta.
