Generally Information and Todo's:

Preparation and Check-in

All yachts are chartered the week before, and we will do our best to work with the respective charter companies to ensure the ships are well-prepared.

After your arrival at the base, you can start with the check-in paperwork.

To shorten your check-in times, we kindly ask all skippers to send the following information and data to office@sailingmotion.com by September 15th, 2025:

- *Sailing- und VHF licenses*
- *First 35 – filled out Crew list by the already sent excel sheet*
- *First 36 – filled out crew list by sent online link*
- *Decision regarding the order for cleaning of the underwater area of your yacht*
- *Prefered Check-out time on Friday*

Information to the bases at Jezera and Biograd

You should have already received this with the charter documents. We will send it to you again along with the crew list templates.

Cleaning of the hull

Please also inform us of this request by September 7th, 2026—some of you have already mentioned it. The cleaning will be done manually by divers, so please do not expect the same quality as when using a crane with a high-pressure cleaner. Additional costs will be announced later

Deposit Insurance

For the deposit insurance, we recommend Pantaenius this year, as their fee for the insurance is more affordable compared to Yacht-Pool or other competitors, and there is no deductible:

First 35 – Deposit to leave at the base: € 3000,00 – Insurance fee € 344,01

First 36 - Deposit to leave at the base: € 2700,00 – Insurance fee € 344,01

Parking lots

-Marina Jezera: Plenty of parking lots are available, parking fee is €7.00 per day

-Marina Kornati West, Biograd: Also there are enough parking lots available, with the regular price being €10.00 per day.

Shopping

In Biograd you will find supermarket called Plodinje with a wide range of food and there are also supermarkets in Jezera. Both the pandemic and the introduction of the euro in Croatia have significantly increased food prices. Our clear recommendation is to shop in Austria or at Czech Republic.

ATM/Cash Machine

-Marina Jezera – There are ATMs both at the marina reception and in the town

-Biograd – Immediately near the marina entrance, there is an [ATM located](#) just outside the marina,

Fuel stations for Yachts

There is a fuelling station directly at the Marina Jezera (First 35) and Biograd (First 36).

Berthing Fees

The entry fee per person includes the following berthing fees:

First 36 in Biograd for the entire week

First 35 in Jezera for the entire week

All yachts – Zemjak: one overnight stay from Sunday to Monday (September 27/28)

All yachts – Sali: one overnight stay from Tuesday to Wednesday (September 29/30)

All yachts – Levrnaka: one overnight stay from Monday to Tuesday (September 28/29)

All yachts – Marina Drage: Thursday to Friday overnight (01/02)

Registration will take place on Sunday from 17:00 at Pizzaria Grill Porat. Please bring the entry fee of €380.00 per person in exact change if possible. The start numbers, if necessary, and welcome gifts will be distributed in the respective marinas beforehand.

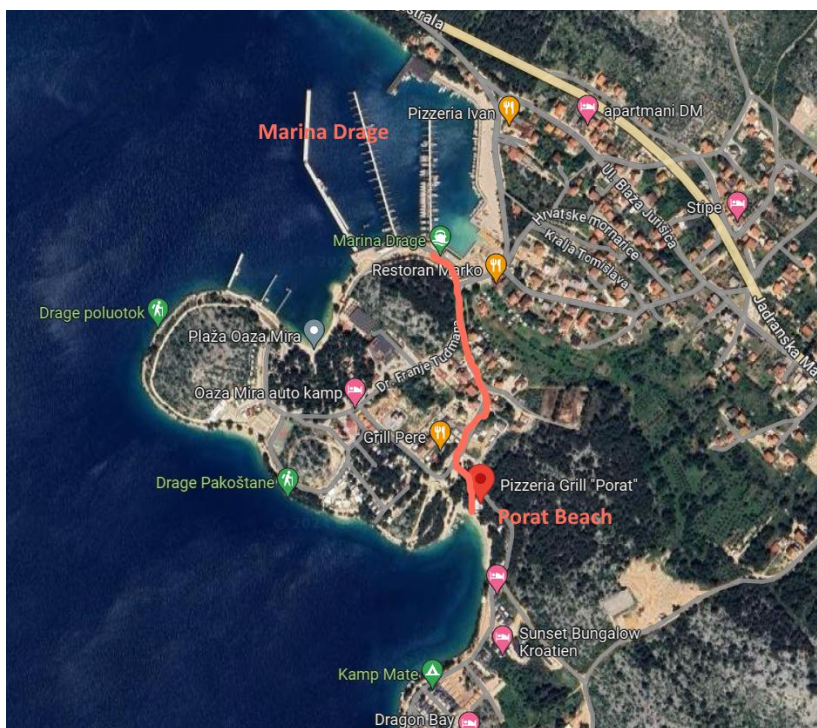
